Foot Notes:

(a**) Mr. Patrick Chalmers of Aldbar mentions that a herd of Angus Doddies was most likely started at Aldbar about 1753, when the estate was purchased by Mr. Wm. Chalmers. In any case, Sheriff Patrick Chalmers (Mr. Chalmers's great grandfather) Bred cattle from 1765 to 1824, and at his death in 1824 he left a stock of cattle that were long known as "the Sheriff's breed", and were said to have been between fifty and sixty years on the farm at the date of his death.
