
THE EMULOUS SIRE LINE





"Spur Emulous Master was recognized as a 100% Golden Certified Meat Sire and was the only fourth generation 100% Certified Meat Sire in the world among all bulls of all breeds at the time, being sired by the 100% CMS sire Emulous Master 209." Emulous Master 209 was a 100% CMS sire, sired by the famous 100% CMS sire Emulous Pride 70 known as Big 70, who himself was sired by Emulous Bob of K Pride who was the world's first qualified CMS sire. This gave Emulous Master 209 the distinction of being the first bull in the world at that time of any breed to be a third generational CMS sire. He went on to sire Spur Emulous Master the world's only fourth generation CMS sire and the first Golden Certified Meat Sire in the world.



"Emulous Pride 70 (Big 70) was a 100% Certified Meat Sire (CMS) with the distinction of being the only bull in the world of any breed to be both sired by a 100% CMS sire and to have sired a third-generation 100% sire." Quote taken from Angus Legends Special Edition Volumes I of II, page 230



"Emulous Bob of K Pride is the only 100% CMS sire of any breed to sire a 100% CMS sire who, in turn, sired a third generation 100% CMS sire. 

(B**) In 1858 the cow Windsor 202


calved, to Hanton, Rob Roy Macgregor was the animal Mr, M'Combie selected to succeed Hanton. It will have been gathered from these remarks that Rob Roy Macgregor had not the violent Angus 45 cross. He was used in the herd with much success, and was followed by his son black Prince of Tillyfour 366, who was out of Maid of Orleans 580 (a daughter of Bloomer 201 and Hanton), and also without the Angus 45 cross. Black Prince of Tillyfour is believed to have been one of the most impressive bulls bred by Mr. M'Combie had again gone as far in the direction of line breeding as his opinions on the subject would permit him; and he then thought it



advisable to have some more fresh blood.
