(a\*\*) The older families at Ballindalloch also bred extremely well. That tracing from Miss Burgess 1198, bred in 1861 by Mr. Burgess, Slack of Ballindalloch, counted among its members Bertha 980, the first-prize cow of the Highland Society at Stirling in 1873; Bachelor 3373, who gained the second prize at Paris, and the first prize as a two-year-old at the Highland Society's show at the Highland Society's show at Stirling in 1881. (b\*\*)The late Baronet (Sir George Macpherson Grant) was an enthusiastic and accomplished breeder. For many years he gave close personal attention to the management of his large and valuable herd, and the success achieved by him was so remarkable that we believe no one will dispute the title of the Ballindalloch herd to the premier position. Which since the dispersion of the Tillyfour herd in 1880, has been generally assigned to it. The influence which the Ballindalloch herd has exercised in the improvement of other stocks could hardly be overestimated. Sir George was specially successful in the rearing of bulls; and

these have been eagerly sought after by breeders throughout the country, in whose herds is equally great in breeding paddocks, the show-yard, and the sale-ring; and this is probably the highest tribute that could be bestowed upon any herd. Pages 66 and 67.
